REVERENCE

It is our hope that everyone will attend the worship services, however, if you cannot attend, please remain quiet and reverent during the worship services. Please help us to see that children refrain from playing games (including swinging on the swings) during these sacred times of morning and evening worship.

RULES & REGULATIONS

Rules and regulations adopted by the Board of Trustees are still in effect to assure an orderly camp meeting. Each tent holder will receive a copy which should be posted for your guests. Note:

*No pets allowed inside grounds. (Pets may be walked on leash behind the tents, only.)

*Each tent should be equipped with a **fire extinguisher**. Inspect the electrical service in your tent. **Eliminate the use of extension cords** to prevent fire hazards.

*No **smoking or vaping** inside grounds

* No open fire pits. No insect repellent candles

*Outdoor **grilling equipment** should be used only in the **rear of the tents** - not on the side, front, or inside of the tents.

TENT REPAIRS

Please cooperate with us as you have in the past. Have tent repairs **completed no later than July 7.**

Please check guttering for repairs and cleaning. Remove moss and debris from roofs. Check water lines, spigots and commodes that may be leaking.

Make any necessary repairs **NOW** so we do not have leaks to be repaired when camp meeting opens.

Please help us by conserving water and staggering showers.

Throughout the year, please be respectful of events (weddings, etc., in progress).

BOARD APPROVAL

Prior to beginning work, the Board of Trustees must review and approve:

*Any new construction

*Any changes made in or around tents (please no digging prior to clearance due to buried utilities).

*Change of tent ownership. Trustee Board **must** be contacted for approval.

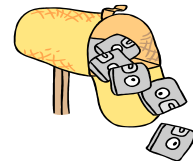
TENT HOLDER'S MEETING
